The CDC / FDA has **updated guidance** for COVID booster shots. These updates are for individuals over 50 and immunocompromised individuals. The current CDC guidance is:

- A second booster dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine or Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine may be administered to individuals 50 years of age and older or immunocompromised at least 4 months after receipt of a first booster dose of any authorized or approved COVID-19 vaccine. This is 2 primary and 2 booster vaccines.
- There currently is no recommendation for a 2nd booster shot for individuals that received one primary and one booster of Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine. This is currently one primary vaccine and one booster vaccine.

St. Anne's will be offering a vaccine clinic on April 20 and 21, 2022 for those wanting a second booster or those needing any other dose of the vaccine. The clinic will be in the Therapy Department and Pauline Hall will be the observation room. The clinic times will be 7:30am-9am and 1:30pm-3:00pm each day. We will have a shuttle available at 8am and at 2pm for those wanting a ride from the campus. Please call 717-285-6199 if you need a ride. We are enclosing consent forms, please complete and return to Lisa Hollywood ASAP so we can ensure we have an accurate dose count for our pharmacy.
