

Guidelines for SARC Independent Residents - Cottages, 100 Merlini & 200 Merlini Apartments and Main Building Apartments

- Please make sure you communicate to Barb or Heather if you were potentially exposed or are positive for COVID-19. Please reach out to your physician if you have symptoms of COVID-19 for their testing requirements.
- Surgical Masks are required whether vaccinated or not, by everyone when in any common area of any building on our campus. The other CDC core principles should also always be followed by everyone - social distancing (at least 6ft) and frequent handwashing.
- All independent residents and visitors/care givers should continue to follow our procedures for temperature monitoring and completion of our screening form when visiting the main building. Individuals visiting 100 Merlini or 200 Merlini apartments do not need to complete our screening process.
- SARC does not coordinate large inside gatherings at this time and we encourage independent residents to not attend or arrange large group gatherings.
- The Bistro and Café are both open. If up-to-date/boosted on vaccines, individuals may sit together. If someone is not up-to-date/boosted, please remember to practice social distancing. The core guidelines are always encouraged for all areas of our campus. Please remember, when you are not eating, you should have your mask on. For those who are not up-to-date/boosted, there are plexi-glass dividers to use during meals,
- The Beauty Shops allow more than one resident at a time, but we still maintain social distancing. Please call Sue Hertzog at 717-808-9433 to schedule an appointment.
- If a resident, who is not up-to-date/boosted, leaves the campus for more than 24 hours, we recommend that they should self-quarantine for 10 days upon return to the campus.
- New admissions must have proof of a negative PCR test result within 72 hours of admission.
- For residents going off campus, we encourage you to social distance, wear your mask and wash your hands frequently
- Current Church services are: Catholic service in the Bistro on Saturdays at 4:00pm, at the main building Chapel on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 10:15am and on Saturdays at 6:30pm. Inter-denominational services are on Sundays at 2pm in Pauline Hall. Please remember for church services, we are still requiring everyone to wear surgical masks whether vaccinated or not. If a resident needs a shuttle for a church service, please call 6199 by 12noon on Fridays to schedule. For those who wish to receive the sacrament of confession, please reach out to Pastoral Care for the current schedule.
- We will continue our off-campus shuttles. Please see the calendar for upcoming events. Please remember when on a shuttle, you must wear a surgical mask.
- Please coordinate through Barb to schedule a caregiver.
