

## **For Independent Residents**

### **Guideline for ongoing re-opening of our campus**

#### **Independent Campus Cottages/Apartments and Main Building Apartments**

- Please make sure you communicate to Heather, Barb or Jennifer if you were potentially exposed or are positive for COVID-19.
- If you are potentially exposed or have symptoms of COVID-19, please contact your physician for testing requirements.
- Outside Visitors Only at this time
- Masks MUST be worn by Residents and Visitors at ALL times for ALL Outside Visits.
- Residents will need to hand sanitize before and after the visit.
- Social Distancing (6ft apart) for ALL Visits
- No Touching/Contact at ANY Visit
- Small Group Activities (Residents only) in building common areas beginning on 8/26/2020
- Bistro: Take Out Service Only until 8/25/2020. On 8/26/2020, we will have 1 Resident/Table unless the Resident shares a Living Space, then the 2 Residents may eat together at the same table.
- Café is open for take-out service ONLY
- Beauty Shop: 1 Resident at a time
- May go to medical appointments
- May go off campus but please remember to social distance, wear your mask and wash your hands frequently
- Church service remains televised. There is no Communion
- No Shuttle Service
- SARC Grocery Service Continues through Friday, 9/4/2020. On Friday, 9/11/2020, we will begin Grocery Shuttle Service for Independent Residents. Only 4 Residents/Shuttle. Grocery Shuttles will run on Fridays ONLY. After 9/4/2020, the SARC Grocery Service will STOP
- Because of the directive from the DOH, any individual who travels to a “hot spot or area of increased COVID-19 activity, should consider self-quarantining for 14 (fourteen) days after return to home. Also, any individual who travels to a state currently on the Department of Health Travel Restriction List should also consider self-quarantining for 14 (fourteen) days after returning to Pennsylvania. This list has been updated from Friday, August 21. The current list includes Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas.
